### Ceding of Post Codes to Dragons Bay – Raised by Lachlahn in response to email from Sir Peter.

Sir Peter has been tasked by the Seneschal of Dragons Bay with opening negotiating with the Barony of Aneala for the transfer of the postcodes surrounding Boddington from Aneala to Dragons Bay. Previously Dragons bay had discussed this with the Shire of Bosenberg but it appears on their checking the Kingdom goggle map that their original postcode claim was not endorsed. In any case the area in question being comprised of 6390, 6391, 6312 & 6308 postcodes is currently allocated to Aneala.

The specific postcode in question is 6390 and contains 1 member and 1 non-member however, in anticipation of future growth Dragons Bay are also seeking the release of 6391, 6312 and 6308.
