Tailors Guild: Pink – an article made out of pink fabric or pinked fabric. Pink, pinked fabric will receive a bonus point.

### May Crown K&I (2006)

Embroidery: Viking Beadwork

Cooking: Sweets that are transportable (example: biscuits, shortbread, cake)

Costuming: Heraldic surcoat

Worshipful Company of Broderers: Seams, hand sewing or seam decoration.

### Midwinter Coronation

#### K&I (2006)

Leatherwork: Elizabethan Doublet

Performance: song from a troubadour (your own composition, in a documentable style, or a performance of an existing piece)

Brewing: an ale or beer

Broderers – Convent Stitch aka klosterstitch

### November Crown K&I (2006)

Calligraphy/Illumination: create a new AOA scroll blank

Engineering: Quintain - plans or completed piece

Dyeing: item (leather or fibre) dyed in yellow or green (the emphasis for this is on the dye / dye process)

Broderers – research with references, any topic, minimum 300 words, or a pattern drafted from a pre-1600 source (eg painting or extant piece)

Columbus is arrested & later released over a dispute following his third voyage.

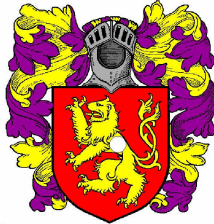
