For anybody who spent time around the bardic circle fire, at Autumn Gathering there was a spiced wine supplied by Mistress Catherine. Some of you seemed to be remembering it the next morning as well. Here is the recipe if you feel like making some:

4L shiraz
1 1/2 cup sugar
1/4 cup cinnamon
1/8 cup ginger
1/2 teaspoon cardamom
1/2 teaspoon cloves
1 teaspoon nutmeg

Warm the wine but do not boil it and dissolve the sugar.

Cool it and add the spices.

Strain through a strainer to get out the goopy stuff.

Then strain through linen and bottle.

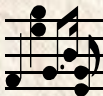
