Appendix A: Archery Marshal's report

A Royal Round was held at Aachenfeld training on the morning of Sunday 2nd Oct 2011. There were four archers on the line. The winner was Catherine de Arc with a score of 46. This was followed by a King's round which was also won by Catherine.

A novelty archery shoot was held on the afternoon of 9th October at the Arabian Nights event hosted by Abertridwr. There were eight archers on the line. The top scoring archers were Alianore de Essewell with a score of 41, Renonys de la Fueille with 39 points and Celestria Ashwood with 36 points.

All IKAC and Royal Round scores for recent months have now been uploaded to the tournament results pages on the Aneala website. A total of 39 archers from our region have submitted scores in the IKAC so far this season. Of these, 16 archers have submitted at least 3 scores and therefore have an average. The current standings in the regional IKAC competition for this season are as follows:

Uffa of Edder with an average of 167, Raynald Greygoose with 131 and Alianore de Essewell with 101.

The next IKAC will take place on the afternoon of Saturday 29th October at Aneala's Baronial Championship. It is proposed that the final IKAC of the season be held at Aachenfeld training on the morning of Sunday 27th Nov.
