After a few more successful meets, I will have a better idea as to whether to take up the offer of a monthly meeting room next month, or the month after.
- College didn't need to hold an official training event, as previously noted.

 - Budget: more of flights put into event budget rather than AG funds than anticipated, still leaving approx \$200 profit, assuming Laurel Freedom Bus funds come through.
 - Mery to be congratulated as Deputy Steward organising classes. Leofric's classes discussed especially enthusiastically.

- Agreed to pay half of Queen's airfares at last council. Including insurance it came to \$427. Moved Dameon seconded Kilic, approved.
- Mery would like approval to pay the Landsdale Farm School the balance of \$1166.
 Moved Gwyneth seconded Catherine approved.
- Nathan would like approval to pay deposit to Ern Halliday for next year's AG. Would require at least as many attendees as this year at comparable pricing. \$2725. AG fund has almost enough. Nathan moves, Dameon seconds, approved.

- WAMA Fayre 16 May. We're on. 8am. We still need a timetable for our individual eric. Weather forecast is horrible. We'll have to wing it.
- Baroness's Fighter Auction. Sunday 21st Jun. Leonie has site invoice of \$421. Nathan moved, Kilic seconded, approved. There has been Some Discussion about who is fighting first.
- Balingup MC 22/23 August. Council has decided not to do this demo.
- May Crown 2016 another bid chosen.
- Arrows for Azincourt 25/10/2015. Have event form. Still waiting budget.
- Midwinter? July 12th weekend out Dragon's Bay feast. July the 4th. At a hall somewhere in Perth. \$35 per head. Renonys as steward, unless she persuades some other sucker good gentle to do it. Approved provided it breaks even. We are assured it will. Nathan firsts, Leonie seconds, approved.
- Baronial Championship 26-28 September. Ern Halliday site is booked. Need a steward. It is a royal event implication 75 people instead of 40. We have Spinnaker booked, which is a bit small for a royal event, hall especially, so we may have to limit numbers (in which case hold some bookings for potential champions at victory feast), or move venue (Landsdale??). We have tentative stewards Branwen and Kilic with assistance from Mery. Mery can phone Landsdale for tentative booking on Monday, Branwen/Kilic can then call Ern Halliday to enquire about moving deposit to AG Anzac Day next year. If they can do so, Mery will pay Landsdale deposit of up to \$2500 (\$2040 last time). We have already approved paying deposit for AG. If we can move that payment to Landsdale, we agree to do it.
- We approve half airfare for Crown to attend. Moved Catherine seconded Dameon, approved.
- We have agreed \$2700 to Ern Halliday for AG next year. We have approved up to \$2500 deposit to Landsdale for Championship if available. If possible we will move the existing deposit paid to Ern Halliday (\$850) for Champ to AG. Moved Gwyneth seconded Catherine, Approved.

Cash at the door payments are being discouraged due to the requirements for receipts to be written. This greatly increases the sign in times at major events. I do get assistance with the sign in at the beginning of events now to reduce the delays.

Almost all those attending events are ensuring they bring proof of indemnity with them if it is not on their membership cards. It is common for a few people each event to present a mobile phone with their membership document/email instead of a membership card.

As far as I am aware, there have been no incidents requiring report - certainly none from the events I have attended.

I am in the process of cataloguing all the lost property for the last 12 months. A list and photographs will be made available and all unclaimed items will be up for auction at an up-coming event yet to be decided upon. "We suggest Fighter Auction.
