  - o Toys for tots report: Rachel- vinnies donation....lots of toys and food items

- Upcoming events
  - May Crown updates: silk banners soon, day rates-feedback is too expensive...much discussion about how to reduce costs......decision to discuss with steward to make final decision....Final decision, the current day rates will stay the same, as kingdom had already rejected a more complicated pricing scheme, it would be difficult to enforce people buying attendance but not feast, and even without feast we pay X-amount per person who steps foot on site, regardless if they eat or not. Anyone with dietary issues is encouraged to contact the feastocrat well-ahead of time and discuss their needs to make sure that everyone is able to enjoy the feasting.
