Reeve - Mery:

Appointment of new Reeve: Applications have closed. Dorothy (Elizabeth) has applied, and her application discussed with Exchequer. Dorothy comes with an impressive resume and, although she has not played in the SCA for some years, Mery has known her for 30+ years and she is Leonie's sister.

- Name submissions in progress: 6. Device submissions in progress: 7, including St Basil.
- I ran a consultation in Bunbury. Available at the College of St Basil's training. I have received several requests from other members of the populace who wish to learn and perform voice heraldry, and as a result I am maintaining a log of upcoming events and heralds to perform at them. Plans to run a tutorial evening on court heraldry.
- Writing a new heraldic ceremony for induction into the Queen's Mouse Guard.

Constable – Lucia:

- Canton of Dragons Bay No report. Regular training is held. Regular archery competitions (IKAC) are held in addition to training.
- Incipient Canton of Vallon d'Or. No report no events that I am aware of.

- I have been unable to attend two events in the last quarter which has been disappointing for me. A roving Constable has filled in on these occasions.
- The new sign in sheets are great and save a lot of double handling. It is much easier to tally up attendance accurately. Proof of membership and indemnity is less of an issue with most people accessing their membership details via mobile phone for confirmation. The issue of indemnities and memberships having differing expiry dates catches many people off guard. It would be good if there is a way for this to be fixed. The Anealan Championship weekend had the King and the Kingdom Seneschal being caught out by this and having to fill in the extra paperwork.
- As far as I am aware, there have been no incidents requiring report certainly none from the events I have attended. We have an excellent Chirurgeon who is available at most events and reports directly to the event steward if she handles any injuries.
- A lost property auction is to be held at the Tournament of St Nicholas on 6th December.

Marshal - Richard:

- College Challenge was greatly enjoyed by all who went. Championship was also a great success.
- Official training for Aneala occurs on Sunday mornings at Lake Monger Primary School, every
 week that does not compete with a group event, and allows for armoured combat, rapier,
 and archery.
- Armoured Training has typically had around 6 attendees. The Honourable Lord (soon to be Sir) Clement, our new Baronial Champion has been introducing drills to training.
- No new authorisations or issues.

Captain of Archers - Kilic:

Archery going on well, 4-6 going to Lake Monger, 6-10 at DB. Combat archery is going well, people enjoyed second tournament. Final IKAC for the year is on Sunday at DB.

Target Archery: Regular practices at Lake Monger and at Wellard on a Sunday Morning. There have been regular monthly IKAC's held on a rotating basis at either Aneala North, Dragons Bay and Abertridwr. We have in all around 10 to 13 target archers that are turning up at least once a month. No issues. We have about 8 Target Archery Marshals, working to get one authorised in Vallon d'Or. Combat archery: 2 recent combat archery tournaments, planning on running one such event every 2 or 3 months. My aim is to double the number of combat archers during my tenure. The only issue we have is cost of armour. Would like to see lower armour requirement for combat archery only tournaments. The only person who has any ramin combat arrow shafts is myself and I have about a dozen left.

Rapier Marshal – Ariel:

- Rapier has been quiet. 2-3 at Lake Monger, 4-6 at College (there have been exams). Droptester has arrived, yay; college mask order in progress.
- Need full SAM testing for everything, due this month.

- Injuries: Nil; Kit: No change; Lake Monger Training attendance: 2-5; St Basil Training attendance: 4-8; Newcomers: None; New Authorizations: 1 Jacques now Rapier Marshal.
- St Basil's College Challenge; Rapier Round Robin Tourney won by Jacques. Also run were Hydra and Basilisk rounds. Contestants and spectators seemed to enjoy themselves.
- Anealan Rapier Championship won by Zaven. Round Robin format with single sword, offhand device and King's Beverage. King Stefan and Lady Sir Eva fought in the single-sword round robin.
- Rapier demo performed by College (3; Zaven, Pantera, Ariel) at UWA Spring Feast.
