- Baroness's Fighter Auction. Sunday 21st June. Press presence. Weather forecast is horrible.
- Midwinter. July the 4th. Cost of Hall \$240 hire + \$400 bond. Spending approved, proposed Nathan, seconded Branwen. \$900 for food, hire costs for equipment \$133. Spending approved, proposed Branwen, seconded Richard.

suggested looking at a plan to recruit in that area as well, because that demo should be good for us. We could run a followup event to try and get people to come along a few weeks after the demo. **Dameon to talk to Pantera and then tell him to get in touch with Nathan to discuss locations etc.
