### **Attendance**

Please refer to the constable report. Numbers were low this year (19 adult members) due to a clash in dates with Balingup Medieval Carnival. This is understandable but also disappointing, and it is recommended to avoid scheduling SCA events on this weekend in future if possible.

### **Site**

We have previously used the same area of Mason's Landing Park and it continues to be a good site for day events such as tournaments or perhaps games days. We did get mundane people wandering past and occasionally sitting nearby to watch, but they were all respectful and interested and did not come in to the bounds of our event. It had been raining so there was some mud at the site. An improvement at the site is that a small brick pathway has been built so that gear can be carried across the little river next to the car park.

We opted not to auction the lost property at this event due to low turnout. At a future event with more attendees, we hope to do the lost property auction.

## **Interim Event report**

*Anealan Championship 21-24 September 2018 (AS 53)*

Steward: Mistress Leonie de Grey (Annette Wilson)

Held at Windmill Camp site, Ern Halliday Recreation Centre, Whitfords Avenue, Hillarys, W.A.

Anealan Championship is held annually, on the September Long Weekend, to choose the Baronial Champions of the Sword, the Rapier and the Bow, as well as the Arts and Science Champion, for the next year.

### **The Camp site**

In the last several years, Championship weekend has been held at a venue which offers dormitory accommodation as well as (usually) camping facilities. This year we were unable to find a suitable site with dormitories, so only camping facilities were available.

Windmill camp site provides flat grassed areas, shade, a large fire pit, and sufficient room for a list field, but not for archery, which took place on the nearby oval. There is an ablutions block (showers and toilets) across the road from the camp site.

Catering facilities comprised a covered area with two gas BBQs, a storage shed with a domestic refrigerator, and plastic tables and chairs for 50 people (in fact only 42 chairs were provided). The covered area has power and lights, and there is a single water tap nearby. In addition to the facilities provided we hired an industrial oven and a mobile cool room, and borrowed gas bottles and gas burners. The cool room was available for the use of all campers, so that food and drinks could be kept refrigerated.

### **Event charges**

The event cost for adults were \$90 for the full event (including dinners), and \$30 for day attendance on Saturday or Sunday (including dinners). Minors 10-17 years old were half price, and children under 10 were free. Non-members paid an extra \$5 for event membership.

Breakfasts and lunches for the full event cost an extra \$20, for all categories of attendees.

### **Attendance**

Sixty four people booked for all or part of the event, of whom four adults did not attend at all. There were eighteen minors, nine of them under 10. See event report for attendance breakdown.

### **Meals**

It was decided to include evening meals as part of the cost of the event, and offer breakfasts and/or lunches for an extra charge, so that people could chose to self-cater if they wished. More than half the campers chose to provide their own breakfasts, but more than half ordered lunches.

Tea, coffee and Milo were provided, as well an urn for hot water, and water was heated for washing up.

Sir Nathan Blacktower cooked Friday evening dinner, over the fire pit. All other meals were organised and cooked by the event steward and Lady Elizabeth Severn.

### **Championship tournaments**

The rapier tournaments were fought on Saturday afternoon. There were three entrants, and the winner was Lord Wolfgang Germanicus. The marshal-in-charge was Master Dameon Greybeard.

The archery contest was held on Sunday morning. There were 14 entrants, and the winner was Lord Thomas O'Cardyf. Lady Avalon of the Isle was the target archery marshal.

The armoured tournaments were held on Sunday afternoon. There were three entrants, and the winner was Lord Richard Ferrowre. The marshal-in-charge was Master Dameon Greybeard.

No incidents or accidents were reported for any of the martial activities. Lady Isobel of Annesley was list-keeper and her report is attached.

The Arts and Sciences Champion, based on accumulated competition entries in the preceeding 12 months, was Lady Isobel of Annesley.

### **Financial report**

Still to be received

The event made a profit of about \$500. Of this \$120 represents savings made by the fact that some of those camping did not actually spend every night on site, which was a saving of

\$10 per person per night. We saved about \$100 in food costs, because surplus food from the investiture event was frozen and then served at this event, which otherwise would have come out of the event budget. So the real profit was in the order of \$300.

### **Post event clean-up**

The Baronial trailer was returned to storage by Lady Isobel, with table-clothes being washed by the steward and returned later. The Cleaning equipment box was restocked, and the Utensils box was emptied, cleaned and the tools sorted, with smaller items sorted into a few plastic boxes to easy access. All the sharps, potato peelers, pizza cutters etc was placed in a box.

### **Steward comments**

The site was a success for this event, although it would have been unpleasant if the weather had not been fine. The under-cover area was adequate for catering, but the power supply was not sufficient for the number of electrical units we had. The urn and the toaster running together tripped the circuit breakers, so cooking, particularly the evening meals, had to be carefully managed.

For this reason, if we use the site again, I recommend that the kitchen NOT be made available for people to do their own cooking.

The period camp area added greatly to the look of the event, but the Barony needs to be careful not to allow the segregation of period and non-period tents to develop into the perception of 'us-and-them' groups in future.
