#### **Listkeeper**

There was one event since the last council meeting – championship on the weekend of 27 to 30 September 2019.

The Armoured Combat Championship consisted of 3 lists in which 3 fighters competed. The winner of each list and the championship was Lord Konrad Hildebrandt.

For the Rapier Championship, 3 rapier combatants competed in 8 round robin lists there being a different weapon combination for each list. Lord Zaven Zeitountsi won 5 out of 8 lists and was declared champion.

For the Archery Championship 6 archers competed in a slot shoot and a king's round. The slot shoot was won by Lord Wolfgang Germanicus. The King's round was won by William de Walford. The championship was determined by a shoot-off at 40 yards. The winner was Lord Wolfgang Germanicus.

The Children's Championship consisted of a boffer tourney and a king's round archery shoot with 6 youths competing in each. The boffer was won by Marek of Vargahol. The archery shoot was won by Taylor. The championship was determined by a game of kubb in which Marek was victorious.

#### **Past Event Discussion:**

27-30 / 9/2019 - Championship - Richard Ferrowre, Mentor Leonie

Still awaiting final food receipts before finalising event. Expected to make a significant profit due to two key reasons,

- a. We had a large difference between people who booked for overnight accommodation, and the number of people who actually stayed overnight.
- b. We had a much smaller than expected children's attendance, meaning the allowance we made to break even on subsidising children, increased our profit.

On the event in general, we had a few complaints about the site, regarding out-of-the-ordinary site problems, all of which were reported to the site - only half the hotplate was working, there were no suitable bin liners left for us (usually supplied by the site!) and wheelchair accommodation was hindered by inwards-opening toilet doors, and a step up into the toilets.

We had generally positive feedback regarding the style and layout of the event, but again with comments raised regarding access to the main area. I should have allowed more space for access around the list field, and I should have allowed a clearly defined pathway from the "Mundane area" into the "In-game" area.
