The Mongolian Tourney Day was an event run in honour of the reigning Mongolian Monarchy in Lochac. It was based on the Mongolian Sports disciplines of Horseback Fighting with archery (embraced in a Tourney where fighters were paired with 1x Armoured Fighter with a Hobby horse and 1x Combat Archer), an archery competition where archers moved along a line simulating riding horses and shooting, horse racing (using the hobby horses) and wrestling (embracing the Viking wrestling style with a little more freedom).

Numbers appeared fairly well represented with 27 overall. The tourney was attended by 4 armoured fighters with 4 combat archers. The Archery Competition had 7 competitors who appeared to enjoy the challenging format.

Setup

Set-up went well with many people assisting and advising with lay out and set up. Set-up went relatively smoothly. We seemed to have most event attendees on site ready for set-up

and I feel this can again be attributed to the activities starting “As soon as possible after Site Set-up” rather than a set time.

Armoured Tournament & Archery Competition

I feel the tournament style was fun and provided a real challenge with teams working on small skirmish strategies. It encouraged teams to work on tactics and to plan how to deal with the armoured fighter and archer on each team.

The Archery Competition took a while to explain, but once explained it seemed to go well with shooters developing strategies to handle the constant movement and changes of position as well as change of focus as the targets got smaller.

We did four 15-20 minute combat demonstrations on Sunday, and three on Monday. The crowd was good on Sunday, with fewer people on Monday due to the very hot weather.
