Youth Officer

To the best of my knowledge, no youth has been harmed. Youth have attended archery with no incident reported to me.

Several youth have been attending rapier, aged approx 11, 13 and 17.

A large event occurred within our lands, Pencampwr/Winters Fest, where approximately 30 youth were in attendance. I have received positive feedback about the youth at this event,

with excellent service from youth, attendance at A & S activities and also some boffer games.

There has been discussion amongst some of the parents and guardians about making more boffer weapons and various standards have been discussed. I have attempted to ascertain if there is a Lochac standard or rule set (if it is classified as combat) or not (a game), and even if not, is there some recommendation standard for how many youth in Lochac will play the game (in case the youth travel - for consistency). I am waiting for the relevant martial officers to decide whether boffer is considered a game or combat. I have recommended it be categorised as a game.

Kingdom level youth awards have been discussed at counsel and the offer to use a similar format for Baronial level awards offered. Our local BnB have elected to continue using the traditional Anealan youth recognition system, the Cygnet awards.

Our BnB have elected to have a youth champion and discussion for how this will look is in process. At this point, archery and boffer will be used to determine a winner, with a separate competition such as Kubbe if a tie breaker is required.

Isolde reports that at Pencampwr-Winterfest she observed children playing inappropriately without supervision with foam weapons.

Some discussion of boffer swords and rattan core foam swords and the various ages that use these and the merits of each.
