Postcodes Discussion

In response to 22 emails received from individual members of our populace requesting a change of group postcode allocation, Aneala Council decided to run a poll of our whole populace to ensure the best opportunity for people to be allocated their preferred group, without adversely affecting other members.

A graphical representation of the results of the poll, without members details (also attached), was presented to council, with my proposed changes to the boundaries. Only the first page was presented to the council for discussion regarding the codes in doubt around the Northern edge, Council agreed unanimously to extend Dragon's Bay South to the extent of 6390, the Southernmost member requesting change to Dragon's Bay, and the second page of the PowerPoint identifies the postcodes affected.

Council agreed almost unanimously (one abstain) to petition Kingdom on behalf of our populace as follows:


