April was a very quiet month. Payments were made for container storage, hire of Darlington Hall and the trailer licence.

The financial report for May Day Picnic has been completed. The event made a profit of \$146.28 once GST had been taken into account.

The cost of container storage has gone up considerably as of this month. We were paying \$3.85 per day but are now being charged \$5.17 per day which is an increase of 35%. The payment for May (we pay in advance) was \$155.10. As this was over the \$140 already approved by Council the B&B, Seneschal and Reeve approved the payment of the additional amount

In addition to the storage costs, Reef is now charging a lift fee of \$11 when we access the container. Up until now, they have not charged us for this but we have just been invoiced this for access on 8th May.

So I would like an ongoing approval of up to \$200 per month to pay Reef for the container storage and lift fees.
