The Vine - We are about to review the distribution of Vine. We have several options - provide a paper copy for all, provide paper copies on request for free, provide paper copies by subscription, or do not produce paper copies at all. This will be discussed at the next Baronial Council Meeting. We may also discuss the value of having copies to give to newcomers

Championship - We require a stewarding team for Championship. The Windmill Camp at Ern Halliday has already been booked. This is the same site we used for Championship last year. Please speak to me or the Baron and Baroness if you are interested in running this event. Bids must be received by next Council.

Candles - Please be advised that coloured and scented candles are not permitted at Anzalan events. Scented candles trigger allergic reactions in a number of our members making events very unpleasant for them. Coloured candles cause permanent staining of our tablecloths and runners. This ban does include "dripless" candles since no candle is truly dripless, especially if there is a breeze or if people play with it during the event. It also includes enclosed candles since large amounts of wax can still be spilt when the candle is removed to extinguish it or if it gets knocked during the event. White and beeswax candles are fine.

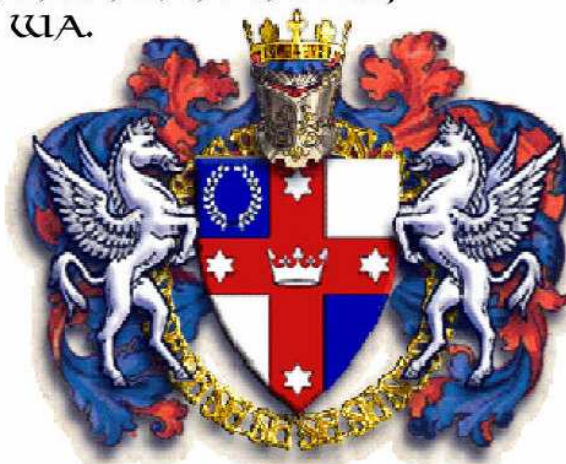

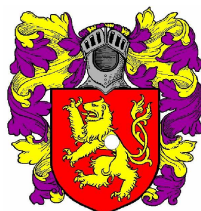

Are you looking for something more in the SCA? Are you interested in being a marshal or a herald?

The Marshal Officer is in charge of armored or "heavy weapons" fighter training, safety on the combat field, and enforcing the armor rules and regulations.

The Herald is responsible for all heraldic matters such as name and device submissions, public announcements and court protocol. He/she also maintains the records of any awards or titles bestowed upon fellow members.

For either of these roles you will be expected to:

- Be a member
- Report to the Lochae Marshal or Herald respectively, the Anzalan Seneschal and the Baron and Baroness every three months. This is quite simple and pro-forma reports are available.
- Attend events and undertake the role of Marshal or Herald.
- Attend council regularly so you know what is going on and what events you might need to attend..

If you think you might have an interest in either of these offices please speak to the Seneschal, the Baron and Baroness or current officers Prospero ab Aqua (herald) or Nathan Blacktower (marshal).
