
From the Senschal

Greetings. There has been some discussion regarding the future of our retired regalia

Ironwing I: It is proposed that wood from Ironwing be turned into the handle for a knife for the Archery Champion to carry. Coronets: It is proposed that the old coronets be turned into chains of office for the Baron and Baroness, and that we continue the tradition of Barons and Baronesses adding a stone to their respective chains. It is likely that these chains will be made by cutting out the swans parts of the coronets and using them as links. This will leave some silver that could be turned into other links. It is likely that other links such as gold demi suns or fealty links might be added to the chains.

Your feedback is requested on these proposals. We are looking for designs and suggestions for how to execute these proposals and also expressions of interest from anyone who wishes to be involved in these projects.






